Summer Financial Aid Programs	
Summer Scholarship	<p>As a result of a gift from the Omidyar family, the Tufts Administration has made funding available to help students pay for Summer Session courses taken here at Tufts. This scholarship is only for students currently enrolled at Tufts University. The amount of funding is limited, and preference will be given to lower income students who need additional coursework to maintain good academic standing and meet their academic goals. (Low income students are generally considered to be those who receive a Pell grant and have a family income under \$40,000/year.) International students are not eligible to receive Summer Session Financial Aid.</p> <p><i>Priority will be given to applications received by March 1st. Late Applications will be accepted after March 1st, but funding may be limited.</i></p> <p>Please Note: The Summer Session Scholarship will only cover the cost of tuition for up to 2 courses. Additional fees, housing, food, and other living expenses will not be funded by this Summer Scholarship. The Federal Direct Loan may be available to assist with other living expenses.</p>
Federal Direct Loan	<p>The Federal Direct Stafford Loan is available if a student hasn't borrowed his/her annual loan limit during the fall and spring semesters. You may look at your award on Tufts Online Financial Aid System to see if you have reached your maximum grade level Direct Loan borrowing. See Loan Limits for grade level maximum amounts. A student must be enrolled for a minimum of 2 courses at Tufts University in order to receive Federal Direct Loan funds for the summer.</p>
